Our room: My family has been working throughout the summer to make our room in the cottage a special place for K-4. It is almost ready for little bodies. Make sure you come by to see it on registration night!

Phase-in: This is a time where smaller groups of children will come to meet with me for two hours. We will have three Phase-in days: August 15, 16, and 17 from 9-11. Your child will be assigned one of those days to attend. This time provides an opportunity for the children to become better acclimated with the surroundings and with me. We will also tour the school, look at some of our routines and expectations, read together, and make something as a group. After your child's Phase-in experience, I am asking you to attend a very short informational meeting. We will have someone supervising your precious one while meet for 15-20 minutes.

Supplies: You should have received a list of the supplies needed for K-4 early in the summer. This list is also available on our school website. As I have been sorting through the items for K-4, I have discovered a stockpile of pencils, 8x 10 inch construction paper, and markers. As a result, please mark pencils off the list. Also, please only get one package of markers and one package of 10x14 inch paper (the big size). If you have already gotten the items on the list, don't worry having to change anything.
