

K4 Exit Expectations

Upon completing **K-4**, a typical student should:

- stay on task independently for at least 15 minutes.
- recite the days of the week and months of the year.
- recognize and write first name; recognize last name.
- recognize and write upper case; recognize lower case letters.
- correctly pair upper case letter to lower case letter partner.
- verbalize the sound associated with consonants and short vowels.
- know phone number, names of parents, and birth date.
- recognize primary and secondary colors.
- be able to listen to a story for 15 minutes.
- understand the concepts of rhyming and patterning.
- count orally from 1-20.
- recognize and write numbers 1-20.
- perform 1 to 1 correspondence in numbers 1-20.
- count orally by 10's.
- recognize circle, triangle, square, diamond, oval and rectangle.
- begin to understand adding and subtracting using manipulatives.
